Brandi Hunt Martin

Brandi began her skiing career in Junior Girls in 1988 in local tournaments in Florida and competed in the Southern Regionals and Nationals for the first time. In the following years as she progressed through the Girls 2 and Girls 3 Southern Regional and National competitions, she had many podium finishes in all events and many overall victories. In the 1993 & 1994 Junior Masters, she had podium victories in Slalom, Tricks and Overall. In the 1996 Junior World tournament, she won Tricks and Overall and placed 2nd in Jump.

In 1996, she also moved to the upper echelon of skiing, entering the Open Women division at the Nationals and was the Tricks and Overall champion at the US Open and had podium finishes at the Masters. She had podium finishes from 1997 to 1999 in the Masters, Nationals, US Open and Pan Am Championships, establishing herself as a strong competitor in all three events and in Overall.

In 1999 she was selected as a member of the Elite Water Ski Team for the first time and competed in the 2001, 2003 and 2005 World Championships as a Team member. She also competed at the Pan American Championships during this time and earned many podium finishes in Tricks, Jumping and Overall with dominating performances.

Brandi held the US National record in Jumping in 2001 with 167' and again in 2002 with a jump of 176'.
